Responsibilities

- Liaise with, develop and maintain industry contacts for Civil Construction.
- Manage Subcontractors with regards to scope, cost, schedule, quality and safety.
- Read, interpret and execute Issue for Construction and Tender drawings along with any associated Specifications.
- Support bid preparation by creating accurate and well-organized estimates and proposals for Construction only as well as Design Build (EPC) contracts.
- Provide engineering support with regards to cost effective and constructible design methods to reduce costs and/or improve quality.
- Organize labour, tools and equipment to ensure project execution targets are met while meeting all safety and quality requirement.
- Negotiate pricing and delivery with material, equipment and service vendors.
- Manage changes in scope for Civil Construction by documenting changes in quantity, material supply and execution requirements. Prepare change order pricing and providing sound rationale against contract documents for requested changes to support the change order(s).
- Supervise the clearing/grubbing, excavation, grading, bedding, and backfilling of all types of excavations.
- Supervise steel reinforcing work, formwork and concrete pouring of foundations and duct-banks.
